Are you living in victory? Maybe you have the 'thrill of victory' in some areas of your life but in other areas you still feel the 'agony of defeat'. Do you feel sometimes that you are taking one step forward and two steps back? I would like to share with you six steps keys to living in victory.

### 1. Know Your Goal

Find out from the Word of God, His will for the situation you are in. His will should always be our goal. For example, if we are sick, we know from God's Word that healing belongs to us. Jesus Himself "...hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows, ...He was wounded for our transgressions, He

was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed." Isaiah 53:4-5 For victory over sickness, our goal according to God's promise is healing. We meditate and focus on God's Word concerning that promise, always keeping our goal in mind. Your goal may be to be a doctor. Do what the prophet Habakkuk says, "And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. <sup>3</sup>For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not

tarry." Habakkuk 2:2-3  
2. **Know Your Enemy**  
"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:" I Peter 5:8 and Ephesians 6:12 "<sup>12</sup>For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." The devil does not want you to live in victory. He knows that if you are in victory, you will bring others with you. (Continued on Page 2)

# Living in Victory

Many obstacles are put up to keep us from accomplishing the will of God in our lives. Don't get trapped by the sound of failure or the sight of a huge 'mountain' blocking your goal. "No, in all these things we are **more than conquerors** through him who loved us." Romans 8:37

### 3. Know the Price Paid

Jesus went through a lot to bring you complete victory. You cannot add anything to His death and resurrection. Jesus did a complete work. Let me say that again, Jesus did a complete work. He paid a high price—His life for your salvation. His victory became your victory the moment you received Him as your Savior.

### 4. Know His Word

God does nothing apart from

His Word. Stop doing things your way and get to know God's way of doing things. Joshua 1:8 "This book of the law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate therein day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written therein, for then you shall make your way prosperous and then you shall have good success." Spend time in the Word. Think about it always. How can we recognize His will if we don't know it? Hosea 4:6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge..."

### 5. Know Who You Are

You are a child of God. Start talking and acting like a beloved child of the God of the universe. God loves you and has chosen to live in you—a

born again believer. Colossians 2:10 AMP "10And you are in Him, made full and having come to fullness of life [in Christ you too are filled with the Godhead-Father, Son and Holy Spirit-and reach full spiritual stature]. And He is the Head of all rule and authority [of every angelic principality and power]." Wow, you have a lot of fire-power in you. The power of Almighty God What can stand against that? Our defeat is not for lack of power, but for lack of using it.

### 6. Know Your God

Our God is the Creator of the universe and beyond. He always was and always will be. His is the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in one. He is the great I AM, the Omnipresent, the Omniscient, ruler of all. Nothing is impossible

with Him. He is your Peace, your Healer and your Provider. He is your Comforter, Guide and Teacher. He is your Savior, Friend and Advocate. All you need is in Him. He is your ever present help, your shelter and stronghold.

Believing and applying these steps will consistently bring victory to you in every area of your life. Living in victory is living with God and by His Word. He has created us to live in victory and given us His name and His Word to do it. It does take effort on our part and faith that He is who He says He is and will do what he says He will do!
